ARTICLE ASSESSMENT

MJPD is a peer reviewed online journal. Each manuscript will be reviewed by 2 independent reviewers who are deemed to be experts in the subject matter. Blinding of manuscript is done by removal of author name, affiliation and any specific references made within the manuscript text. In the event that the two reviewers have contradictory decisions with regards to the acceptance of the manuscript, a third reviewer will be consulted.

CONSENT

The authors need to declare the ethical approval obtained for the research study or the case report submitted. Photographs depicting patients requires written consent from the patient or guardians. The patient should not be recognizable if extra-oral photos are used. If photos depicting patient's face is necessary, the eyes of the patient should be covered.

ARTICLE CONTENT

Authors should avoid submitting similar results to more than one journal. Submitting a duplicate manuscript to another journal simultaneously is not allowed. The author should retract the submission to this journal if they intend to send in the same manuscript to a different journal.

AUTHORSHIP

All the named authors and co-authors should have contributed to the study, data analysis or drafting of the manuscript. All authors should agree to the arrangement of names in the author list prior to the

publication. Any request to add, remove or change the author names must be justified with relevant proof,

PLAGARISM

MJPD takes plagiarism very seriously and will not entertain any use of other author's work without proper citation or referencing. Each manuscript received will be checked for plagiarism and shall not be processed further if found to have a high similarity index.

CITATION

The authors should not be asked to include papers which are linked to the editorial team members or the reviewers for the purpose of boosting their own citations. The editorial team shall also not compel the author to cite MJPD unless the paper is relevant and valuable to the context of the manuscript.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST

Any conflict of interest must be declared in the manuscript. A conflict of interest may arise if the authors are receiving any support or sponsorship which may lead to a bias in reporting.
